Synodality indicates walking together and listening to one another, above all to the Holy Spirit. The fruit of living synodality is receiving and living unity and its fulfillment. It indispensably requires the individual realization of each ones role and duty to live with active participation and collaboration in the life of the Church and in the life of our Province for continuing the mission of Christ as true and credible Pauline Heralds with the authentic sense of satisfaction and fulfillment. Let us be united in prayers and fraternity that we may live fully the time of grace. May God bless us all.

Provincial's Desk



Prayerful Greetings from Cenacle,

"Alpha, Beta, Gama, Delta, Omicron, Sigma, Upsilon, Omega"! These are some of the easily recognized and memorized letters in the Greek alphabet. Most probably, the words of Revelation come from this order of alphabets. "I am the Alpha and the Omega", says the Lord God, who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty (Rev 1:8). This verse of revelation is being repeated at the end of the book too with an addition "I am ..., the beginning and the end" (Rev 21:6) and "the first and the last" (Rev 22:13). This reference of the book of Revelation is commonly and extensively used in the Catholic liturgy. Very interestingly, these letters of the alphabets are often heard in the recent years to characterize the variants of Covid-19 virus.

The letters like Beta, Gama, Delta and Omicron are utilized already to indicate changes, this virus has undergone through mutation. In fact, this virus seems to have undergone thousands of mutations from its origin. No one is willing to communicate to

the world with certainty about this virus and its variants. How many more variants are yet to come, how many more years it would last, how fatal will be the coming variants, etc. Will these letters of be sufficient to indicate the variants of this Virus, no one is able to predict. Viruses constantly change through mutation. When a virus has one or more new mutations it's called a variant of the original virus. Omicron, Delta Cron, Nov Cron, Neo Cov are some of the most recent variants of this virus that we hear from media and other sources. How many more names we are to be familiarized with during this period of pandemic.

We witness helplessness and hopelessness everywhere. As the virus constantly changes through mutation the human scenario too undergoes drastic and sometimes even devastating transformations almost every day. The family scenario is no more the same as precovid-19 times, economic sector witnessed drastic changes, employment sector is no different in this Covid-19 era, the status of faith formation and the life of the Church is also in deep crisis.



Probably, we waited patiently to restart everything after the complete elimination of this pandemic, which does not seem to come to an end. We intended to make over for whatever we have failed to do during this period, which never seems to begin till today. We had so many channel discussions and expert opinions for a post-Covid-19 human society reconstruction, which will never begin without Covid-19 virus is totally eradicated. The appropriate discussion and solution might be a suitable and effective action plan for and during Covid-19 pandemic. There is an interesting episode depicted in the Gospel of John chapter 5; an argument between Jesus and the Jews. Jesus answers to the Jews "My Father is still working, and I also am working" (Jn 5:17). This is the attitude of Jesus and that must be the attitude of every minister of the life and person of Jesus.

Church in India, alike Church in Europe is under deep crisis. Church is attacked, criticized and humiliated constantly unlike before. We the ministers in the Church become scape goats and references of mockery. "When people wish to destroy Religion they begin by attacking the Priest. Because where there is no Priest there is no Sacrifice" well said by St. John Vianney, the Patron of Priests. When a shepherd is

captured, the sheep are scattered in such a manner no more to return or to be gathered again. The situation of the shepherd and sheep is similar today. We are captured and the sheep entrusted to our care are scattered and we may never again meet them or able to gather them together in the future.

Covid-19 pandemic is to be considered as a lightening of Minnal Murali (a recent Malayalam feature film which attracted the attention of global screening), point of enlightenment and divine inspiration, reference of spiritual and moral awakening, and a boom for actions like super heroes. Vocation is an unmerited gift and don't undertake human careers in this unmerited gift given to us as ministers in the Body of Christ (Pope Francis). The first (Alpha) and the last (Omega) letters of Greek alphabet be always the letters of our complete action plan for our priestly life and ministry. Let us not be indifferent, inactive, lethargic, lukewarm in our thinking, in our proclamation of the Good News and in our actions as true agents of Christ. Let us save our Faith, let us save our Mother Church. May the grace of God instil in us the fire of his Spirit and love.

Dear Fathers and Brothers, we are happy to share with you some of the events that have taken place in our various ministries. At the outset of this information we hope and pray that all of you are keeping fine and in good health. In our community we are all keeping fine and so far everything is going on well with us. As we all know since the Covid-19 pandemic, not very many activities are going on in our community Dhonekhona. However in spite of the lockdown we were able to start on time the new academic year 2021-22

through online classes. At the beginning of the academic year we had nearly 250 children but when the government gave permission to have physical classes nearly 100 more students joined our school. So this academic year we have nearly 350 students from class 1 to 10.

We are at the completion of lab, library and boundary wall work, which we had started at the lockdown time. During the lockdown we had a surprise visit by the Provincial Administration, by the Vice-Provincial, Rev. Fr. Saji Pamplaniyil. His visit and stay brought happiness to our community and mission, and we whole heartedly thank him for his presence, care and support. We had already completed our first semester examinations and continued regular classes from fifth to tenth classes. Now our students are getting ready for board exams and waiting for the examination dates to be announced by the state government of Arunachal Pradesh. Although the Covid-19 affected throughout



our state, we never stopped our village ministries. During the Advent season we visited all the villages, and administered the Sacrament of Confession and Holy Mass. Dear fathers we are grateful to you for your constant prayers and support and request you to continue the same so as to strengthen our missionary activities.

Thus we blessed the new house on 26th December on the feast of Holy Family and handed over to his family. Academic Year 2020-2021

We began our first semester classes of the academic year 2020-2021 online due to the pandemic. Selvan Lazar HGN and the Provincial Team made their visit on 17th of January, On the 30th of January, Fr. Saji Sebastian HGN, the then Provincial Superior made his visit to our community. We celebrated his Sacerdotal Silver Jubilee at our Seminary. The Year of St. Joseph was inaugurated officially on 20th of February. We offered a rosary of St. Joseph every Wednesday throughout the year seeking his intercessions for our Congregation. The off-line second semester was completed on 30th May, and Brothers left for their holidays on the 1st of June.

Academic Year 2021-22

Brothers returned to seminary for new intellectual search and thus the



academic year 2021-2022 was inaugurated on July 3rd 2021 in the presence of Fr. B. Balaraiu HGN, the General Councilor, and Fr. Silvester HGN, the Treasurer General of Heralds of Good News. On 31st July, the Ashes of Fr. Stan Swamy was brought to our Seminary and we had Holy Eucharist and special prayers for the departed soul of the social activist who sacrificed his life for the welfare of tribal community in Jharkhand. Suresh Kumar HGN, the Rector.

Jacob Oravanamthadathil HGN, presided over the Eucharist and joined us for the further celebrations. Dr. Paul Maipan, the Bishop of Khammam on the Seminary Day laid the foundation stone for the new venture of Degree College of HGN in the presence of Very. Rev. Dr. Mathew Kallikatt, the Superior General of Heralds of Good News, and very many dignitaries also joined us for the celebrations.

On 25th December we celebrated the birthday of Jesus Christ very solemnly. And on the very next day we, the Pauline Brothers went to our community at Bonakal for the Christmas celebrations, and on 26th of December, we went to St. Paul School. Patharlapadu. We had delicious and sumptuous meals at both the communities and had great time there. Hence we take this opportunity to thank Rev. Fr. Jacob Oravanamthadathil HGN and Rev. Fr. Sibi Thadathil HGN for their timely visit and their love and care towards us. The Josephite family also celebrated New Year and welcomed 2022 with lots of hopes. 
Brothers and they did well. Soon after the exams they left for their holidays. Brothers returned after summer holidays on 17th June.

As beginner I seek the advices and information

and learn from rich experiences of my seniors. My predecessor in the Parishes is Rev. Fr. Reji Joseph HGN. Since he has done a commendable job in the Parish, it is easier for me to continue the good work he has already done. I am happy and satisfied in the place of my ministry as I have a lot of time to relax, read, reflect, meditate and pray as the Parish work in my Parishes is not very demanding and challenging in relation to the many Parishes in India and PNG where some of our brother - Priests are working. MISSION IN GERMANY



Greetings from Germany,

Like in most parts of the world, Germany also is moving along with 'Corona'. There are still a lot of restrictions in effect, but the life is seemingly normal. It takes still some time to have big typical German celebrations like packed football stadiums, wine and beer feasts, carnivals etc. The German people are known for their adherence to rules and regulations. To get out of the corona situations they forgo, though painful, many of their typical favourite celebrations.

The life in the Church also is not much different. Till recently in some parts of Germany it was mandatory to register the names before attending the Church services including the Holy Mass. The Church follows a 3G regulations, Genesen, Getested and Geimpft (recovered, tested and vaccinated respectively). Even during the pandemic, the Church attendance remained rather balanced. But the percentage of practicing Catholics in Germany is between 5 to 7, which means less than the total number of the Syro-Malabar Christians. Alarmingly, high number of persons are leaving the Church

every year. The Church tax (almost 9 % of the income), increasing apathy towards religion and faith, several scandals etc. are the main reasons behind this mass exodus. The children and the youth are almost away from the Church. The number of Catholics and Protestants are almost equal in Germany. But the single large entity is 'no-religion' group. They need not pay the religious tax. The Germans are known for their generosity, open-mindedness and high respect for human rights etc. As we read in Romans 11:5 "So too at the present time there is a remnant, chosen by grace" still there is a very lively and vibrant community of believers. They make use of every opportunity of an encounter with God.

Our Province has 13 working is 4 different dioceses in Germany namely Trier-2, Muenster-5, Eichstatt-2 and Passau-4. We mainly carry out the spiritual activities like celebrating the Holy mass, Baptism, Marriage, Anointing the sick, bringing the Holy Communion to the sick etc. Another main duty is burying the dead. Germany has a very high aged population. I myself have conducted more than 400 burials in over 4 years. We had an annual gathering in November 2021 in the presence of the Provincial Superior and another online meeting in December. All the Fathers are keeping in good health. The winter season is still in full swing and we are expecting warmer days ahead. All the very best wishes to all.
